
The bed base is an integral and indissociable part of the bed.

It is not safe to use this product if any part of the structure is missing or broken. Children could strangle themselves with articles, such as ropes, strings, cords,


harnesses and belts attached to, or hung on this product.

Adjusting Possibilities




Depth Adjustment

after loosening the hinge arm mounting screw



Lateral Adjustment

by adjusting screw



Vertical Adjustment

via mounting plate (via slots or, if in two pieces, via screw)
